



## Viewing Grades & Your Student Progress

### Grades

When your grades for particular course assignments, discussions, quizzes, etc., have been published they will appear on your personal Grades page in the course. In addition, your personal Grades page will also display any feedback from your instructor regarding your grades or performance on assignments and discussions.

1. Click **Assessments** from the navigation bar (1) and click on **Grades** (2).

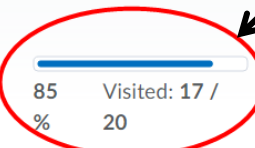
**Displays the percentage% of a module you have viewed/completed along with the number of topics.**
